

## BRANDON BEATTIE (G)



This backyard "G" scale railroad is 5 years old and was undertaken as a project to experiment with engineering and artistry. It features a mountain inspired by Bryce Canyon, several large span wood bridges, 40' of redwood trestles, SVRR code 250 rail, 24 computer controlled pneumatic points and a large train shed acting as a yard. We are currently working on expanding the greenery and recreating green rolling hills and getting into bonsai to help bring more realism to the railroad. Our goal is to one day have 8+ trains operating at once by use of sensors placed below ties and computer operated locomotives.

## SHAY PARK (1.5")



Shay Park comprises of 12 acres and features a train themed playground, pavilion, restrooms, walking and biking paths. The key feature is a portion of the remaining abandoned railroad grade of the Salt Lake & Western Railroad built from Lehi Utah to the Tintic mining district with a connection to the Salt Lake & Mercur Railroad at Fairfield, Utah. Utah Live Steamers Railroad club has built a 1.5" scale railroad in Shay Park with 2,000 feet of track.
