



### **DON AND MERILEE CHAPMAN'S D&M RR. (G)**

The D&M Railroad was established in 2002 and has turned out to be a popular tourist destination for its neighborhood. The battery-powered layout boasts two loops which support 240 feet of track. The track runs around a water feature and a lazy creek, while a large cottonwood tree provides ample shade. Most recently, the addition of a smoking volcano has increased interest. Don, a creative craftsman, has hand-made the entire layout from scratch and maintains and repairs the engines. Merilee, an amateur gardener, focuses on plant selection environment maintenance. New ideas and improvements keep it an interesting on-going hobby for both of them.

### **BURKE AND ERIN WORTHINGTON (G)**



Burke and Erin Worthington's railroad was started in 2015 and has approximately 400 feet of track and 11 switches. To keep the trains safe when not being run, he has a tunnel leading to a storage area under his deck. The layout features a number of scratch-built rocks, buildings and bridges. In addition there is a 650 gallon pond, 40 foot stream and two waterfall, one of which drives a waterwheel. The layout is dedicated to their father and grandfather, Samuel Lee Worthington, who was a railroader for 50 years including being the engineer on the California Zephyr between SLC and Elko, NV.
